Asia and the Pacific: Afghanistan

Save the Children developed a brief based on interviews with more than 70 children between the ages of 6 and 15 across seven provinces in Afghanistan, including Balkh, Faryab, Jawzjan, Kandahar, Kunduz, Nangarhar. Interviews were conducted at the end of May 2020. While children themselves are not considered to be the most at-risk in contracting COVID-19, their responses demonstrate the widespread reverberations that the pandemic has had on their lives, from the closure of schools to increased food insecurity.
