Europe and others: Spain

Ten groups of children in five different cities meet virtually once a week to discuss concerns, share ideas, and undertake their own projects (without leaving home) with the support of a youth worker. These groups were created just when the pandemic arrived and Spain declared the state of emergency; however, the plan is that these participation groups will continue well after the state of emergency is over and they will meet in person (off line). Currently, these groups are analysing and discussing the type of society they would like to see when the COVID-19 pandemic is over, and are elaborating policy recommendations and suggestions for the advocacy team at Save the Children to take them in consideration in their advocacy work. Some of these groups have also participated in consultation with the local government of Barcelona and the Regional Government of Valencia.
